Perimeter Overflow

The ultimate "how did they do that?" swimming pool feature, perimeter overflow offers a stunning effect. The water's surface looks like a flat sheet of glass and appears to be perfectly contained — without walls.

In perimeter overflow, the pool water overflows its edges and flows into a hidden slot or catch basin where it's then recycled back into the pool.

It's similar to an infinity-edge pool, but with a perimeter overflow, the water overflows on all four sides.

It's hard to stop staring.

Besides the obvious stunning visual impact of water moving across a plane, water in transit features like this also offer acoustic delight.

As soon as you hear moving water, it relaxes you. It's why resorts and high-end hotels always have water features. You can't beat them for bliss.



Caves

Caves create an alluring sense of mystery in a pool. Secluded and enchanting, they lure both kids and grown-ups with potential for adventure — without leaving the yard.

Surrounded by waterfalls, colored lights and more, caves offer a unique space to relax and cool off in the shade.

A cave can be extravagant, with multiple rooms and swim-up bars. Or it can be a cozy, intimate spot nestled behind a waterfall.

Sun Shelves

Automatic Covers

Every pool needs a cover. It's the best way to protect the investment you've made in your pool. Even the smallest debris falling into your pool can lead to liner tears, water imbalances or damage that could be expensive — and a nuisance — to repair. The most luxurious cover is automatic — no cranking a wheel to put it in place.

Simply flip a switch or press a button. Your pool is ready to enjoy or closed up tight in less than a minute. The cover is concealed within an integrated housing when the pool is in use.

Automatic safety covers provide a virtually impenetrable barrier between your pool and its surroundings. It's a great safety feature for families with small children and pets but also helps insulate the pool and lower heating costs.

Viewing Panels

Yes, you can add underwater windows to your pool. Or create one whole wall of your pool from see-through acrylic panel. These viewing panels allow natural light to flow into your pool.

Plus, it's fun to watch people splashing around, aquarium-style.



Laminar Jets

Laminar jets produce clear or lighted arcs of water up to 7 feet high and 8 feet wide that arch into your pool with a soothing sound to create spectacular backyard entertainment.

The clear arcs of water by day transform into an impressive colorful light display at night. Multiple jets can be combined and synchronized for a dazzling light show you control.

Waterfalls

Slides

When coordinated with the surrounding landscaping or incorporated into a cave, a waterslide becomes an exciting part of a backyard oasis. Opt for twists and turns, curves, steep inclines or straightaways for speed.

Intriguing New Materials

Travertine and marble take center stage for poolside patios. They're elegant, and cooler under your feet than bluestone.

The natural play of light off glass tile has everybody mesmerized. Its reflective quality against the water is stunning. It creates a sleek and sophisticated look that can be used throughout the whole pool or as a luxurious accent.

Plaster finish tinted with colored dye has been the king of pool interiors for decades. Scoot over, plaster. Aggregate pool finishes are the latest pool surfaces. White or colored plaster is mixed with small pieces of quartz, granite, river stones, or glass beads.

These trendy finishes provide a luxurious pool surface that's harder and more resistant to chemicals and staining than plaster alone. They also offer an array of stunning colors and textures and can be custom blended to create a unique look.
